**Footnotes**

SPY PARK vied for the lead three wide, forged command after a half, shook clear entering the stretch, then was fully extended to just last. RONIN JUSTICE was unhurried into stride along the inside, got through to make a steady advanced, drifted out late under left handed urging, bumped SHOFAR and just missed. ALL WEST settled saving ground, split horses leaving the turn to launch his bid, angled to the outside for the final furlong, loomed large but was just kept at bay. SHOFAR contended along the inside, drifted out a bit entering the stretch, was bumped late and steadied when RONIN JUSTICE came out and lost his best chance. VODEL was forwardly placed between rivals, shifted out five wide leaving the turn, offered a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. SMAK DAB was hustled along four wide while never far back, but weakened leaving the turn and faded. WARRIOR ACE prompted the pace along the inside, drifted out a bit leaving the turn, faltered from between horses in the drive and gave way. ROYAL ENSIGN settled along the inside, angled out entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. SOME KINDA TROUBLE showed little. OROGENIC contested the pace from between horses for a half and dropped out. GRAND EDITION was always outrun. VICARY was through early. The jockey of SHOFAR lodged an objection against RONIN JUSTICE for alleged interference in deep stretch, but following the review the Stewards made no change to the order of finish.
