Footnotes

SUDDEN WAR (ARG) prompted the pace to the outside of CAJUN PRIZE, took over entering the stretch, shook clear and held a diminishing advantage. GUADALCANAL was close up along the inside, shifted out entering the lane, split horses and was getting to the winner late. DR. ALEX attended the pace in hand, launched a bold bid three wide leaving the second turn, but lacked the needed late punch. CAJUN PRIZE set the contested pace along the inside to the stretch and gave way. HYRACOTHERIUM was allowed to settle, move up to make a mild bid three wide with a quarter to run but failed to sustain the drive. WEGGIE was unhurried, made a belated gain three wide but was never a factor. PAISANO CREEK saved ground to no avail. CHURCH SERVICE lagged near the tail of the field and failed to respond.
