STAKES Lexus Raven Run S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$12,500 by time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$1,250 to enter and an additional \$1,250 to start, with \$250,000 guaranteed, of which \$150,000 to the owner of the winner, \$50,000 to second, \$25,000 to third, \$12,500 to fourth, \$7,500 to fifth and \$5,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I in 2010 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade II in 2010, 4 lbs.; a Grade III or \$58,800 once in 2010, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Lexus Raven Run will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen fillies pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference to graded stakes winners, then highest earnings in 2010. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 13, 2010 with 27 nominations.

HILDA'S PASSION vied for the lead four wide, opened clear after a half, dug in to meet the challenge of DECELERATOR and held sway with dogged determination. DECELERATOR stalked the pace, moved up three wide to make a bold bid, was unable to best the unyielding winner but stayed on well for the place. TREMENDAMENTE LOCA settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch, finished well and was getting to the top two. KITTY IN A TIZZY

veered out at the start and was slow into stride, recovered quickly and rushed to contention between horses, loomed a threat four wide entering the stretch, but flattened in the final yards. CHANTILLY NAYLA tucked in and attended the pace toward the inside, shifted out and bid between rivals entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. MUCH REJOICING bobbed and bumped with SPEEDY SPICE at the start, was unhurried and lagged well back, made a belated gain six wide but was left with too much to do. NEGLIGENCE contended between horses under a snug hold, angled in entering the stretch but went evenly through the drive. SPEEDY SPICE was bumped at the start and off slow, made a middle move five wide to close the gap but faltered entering the stretch and faded. RED HOT BUDDHA was hustled along four wide in mid pack but lacked a response when asked. DISTORTED PROMISE saved ground to little avail. BEAUTICIAN was allowed to settle, angled out but failed to menace. KATY NOW showed little. PLATINUM EXCHANGE rushed up to vie for the lead off of the inside, dropped off of the pace before going a half, came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out.
