Footnotes

SURINA STAR, outsprinted early, saved ground into the stretch, came out and split foes three abreast approaching the final furlong, took over and won going away under intermittent urging. ARCILLA, never far back, circled horses six wide into the stretch and wasn't a threat to SURINA STAR while earning the place. LAUNCHALUCKYSTAR saved ground while stalking the leaders to the stretch, moved four wide to rally, loomed boldly for the last eighth but came up empty. DREAM SCHEME gained the lead early, moved inside, lost the lead to IT'S AN ECHO from the outside early on the turn, held on well until the final furlong and faltered. IT'S AN ECHO went up outside front-running DREAM SCHEME early to press the pace, reached the front on the turn, held on well into the stretch and gave way the last eighth. CORAL SEA was outrun in a dull effort.
