JULIE JALOUSE, reserved inside early, moved three or four wide on the backstretch, circled horses eight abreast into the stretch and drove clear late. HIGH POTENTIAL followed the leaders five wide from early on, raced within easy striking distance, bumped with DAISYAGO at the quarter-mile ground while rallying inside that one, gained even terms for the lead but wasn't able to match strides with the winner late. BELLS FOR MARLIN moved inside early, eased out to advance between foes three wide concluding the backstretch, gained a slim lead briefly, continued close up into deep stretch and faltered. DAISYAGO, rated four wide early, angled out seven wide on the backstretch, moved steadily five wide approaching the stretch, bumped for a stride with HIGH POTENTIAL, dueled on even terms into the final furlong while coming a bit wider, then weakened when the test came. BEE MY HONEY tracked the pace three or four wide, moved to a narrow advantage while continuing four or five wide into the final furlong but failed to continue. REINA BLANCA (GB), never far back while between horses three or four wide, was put to a drive at the quarter-mile ground, swung out seven wide for the drive but couldn't produce the needed response. AMARETTA gained the lead early, maneuvered near the inside, showed until the second turn and faded approaching the stretch.
