Footnotes

TINGWITHASTING tracked the pace from early on while four wide, inched to the front entering the upper stretch, then drew off in the final furlong under steady encouragement. WATEREE, bumped at the start and outrun for a half, raced in behind rivals near the inside to the lane, eased out between foes three wide for the last eighth and bested the others while not a threat to the winner. SISTER CAROLINA, outsprinted early, made a run four wide into the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. LILA KAY'S ROSE contested the pace between foes until the final quarter and gradually weakened. BEST CONTEST, outrun for a half, made a mild run into the upper stretch but was finished soon after. SAPPHIRE LADY, forwardly placed in behind the leaders to the stretch, was empty in the drive. VERA CLAUDINE, outrun to the stretch, passed only tired foes. HARBOUR BUOY, bumped after breaking sluggishly and forced in on WATEREE, was six wide on the backstretch and never prominent. JOSH'S MADELYN, bumped by WILDCARD CAT and forced in on HARBOUR BUOY, followed the leaders in a contending position five wide to the stretch and faltered. ROYAL PARADE raced in contention inside for five furlongs and weakened thereafter. WILDCARD CAT ducked in on JOSH'S MADELYN at the start, forced that on in, continued inside to gain the lead, made the pace for a half and weakened soon after. The field was tardy coming onto the track because of difficulty setting the tack on HARBOUR BUOY.
