Footnotes

TCHOPITIOULAS exchanged bumps with PROF. MCGONAGALL just after the start, was never far back while four wide, edged closer between foes on the far turn, angled five wide into the lane, stuck a head in front a sixteenth out, then prevailed under strong handling when bumped nearing the wire by PROF. MCGONAGALL and carried out a bit. PROF MCGONAGALL exchanged bumps with the winner early, gained the lead, raced near the inside under careful handling, shook off a challenge from AUTUMN GLOW nearing the stretch, then couldn't last while drifting out late and bumping the winner. BORDER BLUES, in hand four wide, moved menacingly between rivals entering the upper stretch, was steadied at the three-sixteenths pole, angled five wide in deep stretch and was going well at the end. LICENSE TO SPEED, well placed from the start, raced near the inside, made a solid rail bid into the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. SWING THE CAT (NZ), allowed to settle and five or six wide throughout, made a mild run into the upper stretch but flattened out when the test came. SHUREAMSWEET, unhurried early and three or four wide much of the trip, lacked a closing bid. OH MY LOVE, three or four wide most of the way, failed to rally. AUTUMN GLOW chased front-running PROF. MCGONAGALL from between foes three or four wide to the stretch and tired. SERVING MA MAN tracked the pace four or five wide for six furlongs and weakened gradually thereafter. LADY SABRINA, well placed near the inside between foes until the final quarter, weakened thereafter.
