**Footnotes**

RED ALERT gained the lead at once, controlled the pace under careful handling, then drew off when kept to his task in the late going. QUICK PAY, fractious in the gate prior to the start, settled early, raced five wide around the far turn and into the stretch, then couldn't challenge the winner while superior to the others. POR SUPUESTO hopped while breaking slowly, was never far back, made a run from between foes three or four wide into the upper stretch and improved position while unable to menace the top two. MARROUCHE, well placed along the inside into the upper stretch, was empty when the test came. DRAWN, between foes three or four wide early, moved inside on the far turn, came out again to be between foes five wide for the drive and lacked a serious late bid. WAR TRACER chased the winner three or four wide into the stretch and weakened. POLO GROUNDS, outrun to the far turn, was put to a drive three furlongs out, circled foes six wide into the lane and couldn't sustain the needed momentum. A NICE SPLASH, in contention four wide for six furlongs, weakened gradually. WHOLE NINE YARDS tracked the pace four or five wide, was asked for more at the five-sixteenths pole and flattened out. ACT OF WAR, outrun two wide to the stretch, came out four or five wide for the drive and never menaced.
