Footnotes

MA RAINEY settled saving ground, advanced from between horses through the second turn, angled out to continue the drive, caught TURN TO BERNSTEIN inside the furlong marker and quickly drew clear. The latter settled in hand, launched her bid three wide nearing the three-eighths pole, opened clear entering the stretch, finished willingly but was unable to match strides with the winner late. ESTRELLA VICTORIA was unhurried into stride along the inside, made a steady advance to close the gap, angled out entering the stretch and was along in time to earn the show. HITCH YOUR WAGON tracked the pace three wide for five furlongs, dropped back on the turn, came again racing five wide and improved her position late. CLEVER THOUGHT stalked the pace along the inside, made a middle moved and forged a narrow lead with three furlongs to run, but weakened entering the stretch and gave way. KERMITRA was hustled along three wide in the second flight, angled in entering the stretch and finished with a belated gain. HAPPENSTANCE pressed the pace two wide to the stretch and dropped out. LANGZIG failed to respond. SO EASY showed little. ROOIBERG set the pressured pace along the inside to the three-eighths pole and stopped.
