### Footnotes

ORDINATION (IRE) reserved while three wide and within striking distance, angled in on the backstretch, moved up along the inside on the second turn, was blocked in upper stretch, was carried when angling outside the leader soon after bumping COOLCULLEN TIMES (IRE) out then finished well to be clear. SAL THE BARBER vied for the lead off the inside, drew clear on the second turn, drifted out in upper stretch carrying the winner out then held on for the place. CABERNEIGH forwardly placed three wide, moved out a path on the second turn, was carried out in upper stretch and held on gamely. QUITE A HANDFUL forced the pace three wide and tired in the drive. COOLCULLEN TIMES (IRE) close up along the inside, challenged before a half, dropped back a bit into the second turn, was bumped and forced out by the winner in upper stretch and tired. SILVER MOUNTAIN was no threat.
