Footnotes

FEAR THE KITTEN attended the pace toward the inside, shifted out and split horses leaving the turn, drew even inside the furlong marker, wore down GREENGRASSOFYOMING and was inching away late. GREENGRASSOFYOMING stalked the pace, ranged up to join the leaders three wide, forged command entering the stretch, continued on willingly but was unable to resist the winner. GRAND KUMA tracked the pace three wide, moved with the winner through the second turn, kept on fairly well and was just up to earn the show. TATES HUMOR was close up three wide, moved up to engage the leader after a half, disputed the issue to the final furlong and faded. ALIMONY COBRA opened clear to set the pace, was collared after a half, contested the pace through the second turn and retreated. GRAND MAST brushed the gate and was away slowly, was unhurried into stride and showed little thereafter. FANCY HENRY was fractious in the gate, broke in the air to get away well behind his field and was never a factor.
