Footnotes

STYDAHAR, unhurried for a half and three or four wide, advanced between rivals leaving the backstretch, eased outside front-running BRENT'S VICTORY when entering the stretch, caught that one a sixteenth out and proved gamely best under strong handling. BRENT'S VICTORY ducked out at the break bumping VALIANT KING, moved up soon after to track front-running CAPTAIN NICHOLAS four wide, inched to challenge approaching the stretch, took over, briefly was clear, then failed to withstand the winner's surge. VALIANT KING, bumped at the start from both sides, raced between rivals three or four wide, remained prominent into the final furlong and lacked a late response. CAPTAIN NICHOLAS gained the lead early, moved in two or three wide, lost the advantage to BRENT'S VICTORY approaching the stretch and tired. BUCKLE DOWN BEN ducked in at the start bumping VALIANT KING, followed the leaders five wide and was empty when straightened into the stretch. POINT PRINCE, within striking distance three or four wide to the end of the backstretch, weakened thereafter. ILLUSIONARY, reserved inside early, raced in a contending position into the final furlong while continuing inside and flattened out. SHADY VALLEY well placed inside early, eased out three or four wide on the backstretch, raced within easy striking distance to the stretch, angled five or six wide for the drive and tired.
