M B SEA, never far back, leaned in and exchanged bumps with SONIC WEST approaching the first turn, moved four wide entering the backstretch to track the dueling leaders, inched to challenge approaching the stretch, was bumped for a stride about the three-sixteenths pole by TENPINS when that one came out slightly, took over, drifted out for a stride under left-handed whipping at the furlong grounds, then continued under pressure to prevail. TENPINS went up to vie for the lead early while outside of QUEST, battled on near even terms with that one, put a head in front for a stride or two entering the lane, came out and bumped with the winner, then couldn't sustain the needed momentum as second best. CHANGEINTEWEATHER, well placed in behind rivals from early on, raced within easy striking distance, angled between horses four wide about mid-stretch and offered only a minor gain while dead heating for third with SEATTLE FITZ (ARG). The latter brushed the side of the gate while breaking a bit sluggishly, settled three wide early, continued in behind horses entering the stretch, split foes three wide in the final furlong and finished on even terms with CHANGEINTEWEATHER. SONIC WEST, between horses early, came out and exchanged bumps with M B SEA nearing the first turn, raced four or five wide, angled six wide to offer a mild bid into the final furlong but failed to continue. COUNTRY BE GOLD, outrun four wide to the far turn, made a mild run and angled seven wide into the stretch but was empty the last eighth. QUEST gained a slight edge inside early, dueled with TENPINS through moderate fractions and faltered in the drive.
