STRONG RESPONSE sprinted clear, set the pace near the rail and drew off under steady urging. RUPANSU forwardly placed from the start, raced in the four path on the turn, lodged a mild bid leaving the turn to reach closest to the winner, could not threaten that one in the stretch but held on for the place. BEMATA out sprinted early, raced five wide midway through the turn and improved his position in the stretch. KAMCHATKA within striking distance three wide, lacked a late bid. INDYGOFLYER close up in the three path, held well to the stretch and tired. BRINK OF WAR forwardly placed off the rail, also tired. GUESS MY NAME outrun in the three path, failed to menace. BIG SAM was no factor along the inside. LAYTON REGISTER outrun early, raced six wide midway through the turn and was no threat. TIZ THE KID drifted in at the start and steadied, raced close up for a half near the rail and stopped.
