**Footnotes**

UNLATCH attended the pace along the inside, shifted out leaving the second turn, split rivals five wide entering the stretch, kicked on well and edged clear. GRAND ARCH stalked the pace, launched his bid four wide, forged command with a furlong to run, continued on willingly but was unable to resist the winner. SET THE SAIL settled saving ground, took closer order through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch and was along for the show. MASTER ACHIEVEMENT opened clear and tucked in to set the pace toward the inside, was collared entering the stretch and weakened in the drive. INTERNALACCOUNTING chased three wide, but faltered between horses after six furlongs and faded. FILM MAKING was unhurried into stride, rallied between horses five wide and improved position. NICKLAUS WAY was allowed to settle, angled out and finished with a belated gain. WHAT A LOOSECANNON made a middle move five wide to close the gap but came up empty after six furlongs. PAROLED broke in the air and passed only the tiring ones. TRUE STRIKE contended off of the inside for five furlongs and dropped out. PURGENALITY showed little. HAND I WAS DEALT was hustled along five wide for six furlongs and retreated.
