Footnotes

IRISH FANTASY, well placed from the outset while in behind the dueling leaders, advanced four wide approaching the stretch, took over and quickly moved clear, then was kept to her task. SIREN SONG, bumped at the start and outrun for a half, edged closer inside around the turn, moved out to rally from between foes four wide, was just off the winner for the final furlong and couldn't offer a challenge as second best. CECILIA'S CROWN leaned in at the break bumping SIREN SONG, was outrun for a half while five wide and offered a mild gain. COUNTESS MARQ, five or six wide throughout, offered a mild bid nearing the final quarter and flattened out the last eighth. SUDDENLY GONE, outrun for a half, improved position but wasn't a threat. DAINTREE, well placed near the inside between foes for a half, failed to continue. MOMENTS OF JOY gained a slim lead early while dueling outside of TWO DOT SLEW, held on well for a half and weakened gradually. TWO DOT SLEW went up inside to contest the pace early, dueled with MOMENTS OF JOY, gained a slight edge on the turn but tired approaching the stretch. BLUE DIAMOND RUN, well placed near the inside for a half, tired thereafter.
