Footnotes

BANANAS, close up from the start, was taken in hand and eased back in behind the dueling leaders, swung out five wide to reach the front in the upper stretch and edged clear late under strong handling. MOUNT EVEREST, never far back and six wide on the backstretch, edged in a bit on the turn to force the issue, battled on even terms with the winner while inside that one in the upper stretch and couldn't match strides late as second best. DIXIE'S BAND dueled for the lead from the outset while near the inside between rivals, battled on even terms for the lead into the final quarter and gradually weakened. LOST AGENDA, a forward factor between horses five wide early, was eased back leaving the backstretch, continued four wide and failed to rally. EXPLOSIVE COUNT contested the pace from the inside at once, dueled on about even terms for the lead into the upper stretch and weakened. FORD EVERY STREAM attended the pace from early on, raced between foes three abreast and weakened when straightened for the drive. TABLE TALK swerved out badly at the start, was checked, raced six or seven wide throughout and failed to menace.
