Footnotes

SOLDIER GIRL, up close inside early, eased outside of front-running LORDLY on the backstretch to track that one four wide, took over in the upper stretch and was hard ridden the remainder. FULL OF IDEAS, never far back and four or five wide, gained about even term with the winner for the final furlong and couldn't match strides in the late going as second best. SOUSAPHONE broke slowly, raced near the inside to the lane, split foes three wide and couldn't offer a final bid. JUST HOPING, outrun five wide early, came out seven wide for the drive and managed a minor gain. LORDLY, well placed along the inside to the head of the stretch, eased out three wide for the drive and was empty. ANDMOREAGAIN, outrun three wide to the stretch, circled horses ten wide and improved position. YOU CALL THAT ART, within striking distance and between foes to the head of the stretch, flattened out in the drive. STELLAS NEW GROOVE, unhurried early and five wide, made a mild run on the far turn but was empty when straightened for the drive. COMEDY gained the lead early while two or three wide, made the pace for six furlongs and weakened gradually. ROYAL SNEAK was outrun and ten wide in the stretch drive.
