**Footnotes**

TWO CATS settled near the inside early, moved between foes three wide leaving the turn, continued out five wide when straightened for the drive, exchanged brushes with COWBOY SHOES at the three-sixteenths pole and drove clear late. CLASSIC R. J. dueled for the lead three or four wide while outside of BLACKSTONE RIDGE, battled with that one into the final furlong and wasn't a match for TWO CATS in the late going. BLACKSTONE RIDGE gained a slight edge inside early, dueled with CLASSIC R. J. into mid-stretch and grudgingly weakened. COWBOY SHOES between foes four wide and never far back, exchanged brushes with the winner in the upper stretch and couldn't muster the needed late gain. GOLD APPEAL raced between foes three or four wide and weakened in the drive. NET PRESENT VALUE, within striking distance and between horses three or four wide into the final furlong, couldn't offer a late response. THREE MAN BAND stalked the pace five to the stretch and came up empty. WHY BE QUIET raced in contention between horses four wide to the final quarter and tired. PATRICKS CALL raced in contention near the inside for a half and tired. FIRST TIME never was prominent. BLACK LIMO, six wide while outrun early, came wide into the stretch and never threatened.
