CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE gained the lead two wide early, dueled with NATIVE RULER around the turn, put that one away, moved well clear and was going under energetic hand urging at the end. MY PAL ALEX, outsprinted early and near the inside, was not threat to the winner at the end while besting NATIVE RULER for the place. NATIVE RULER forced the pace from early on while outside the winner three or four wide, battled up close to the stretch and weakened. SWEET STRAWBERRY, well positioned along the inside to the final quarter, angled five wide for the drive, had aim and came up empty. TRIPBIT, outrun for a half, fanned seven or eight wide for the drive and improved position. KILN CREEK was well placed five wide to the head of the stretch and flattened out. DAKOTA HILLS raced near the inside and failed to threaten. DEVIL DOWN tired after a half. METZGER raced four wide and faded approaching the stretch.
