SARAROYAL was allowed to settle, circled five wide, wore down the leader and was up in the final strides. POBRECITA opened clear to set the pace, fought on gamely but was unable to resist the winner. BOM BABY was allowed to settle, advanced between horses through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch, split horses but lacked the needed late response. DOWER broke slow, settled saving ground, got through and was making up ground. IT'S TIFFIN TIME was hustled along between horses four wide, finished with a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. ROYAL MARQUE stalked the pace, launched her bid two wide, but weakened between horses in the final furlong and faded. LADY WYNNE settled saving ground, got through but lacked the needed late response. SUNDAY SHOES was allowed to settle, came five wide and finished with a belated gain. MAESTRO MISS failed to respond. ROMANTIC INTENTION was never factor. PIG SOOIE contended between horses, but came up empty leaving the second turn and dropped out. CHEER FOR ME GIRLS was close up four wide, was collared between horses on the second turn, was put in tight, steadied near the five-sixteenths pole and stopped.
