Footnotes

MIDDIE reserved early three 3wide, moved in a bit on the backstretch, split rivals entering the second turn, angled out a bit with less than three furlongs to go, was carried out entering the stretch, wore down the leader, drew clear then held sway late. VOODOO STORM reserved along the inside, followed the winner into the second turn, moved outside that one near the three furlong marker, was carried out entering the stretch then was gaining late. J ISLE set the pace near the rail, held on well to the final sixteenth and weakened. ATOM SPLITTER outrun early off the inside, moved out four wide approaching the stretch and made a late gain on the outside. READY TO TAUNT reserved off the rail, made a run four wide on the second turn but went evenly late. CODOY forwardly placed off the inside, lacked a closing bid. DAVID D outrun early along the inside, was no factor. COLONIAL'S SCORE prompted the pace three wide and tired. WIN IT four wide on the first turn, faded in the final three furlongs. NIGHT PARTY prompted the pace off the inside and stopped.
