MURPHYS COVERT outrun early, advanced four wide on the second turn, responded in the stretch and closed well between the leaders to be clear. FLATTERMEJIM close up while off the inside, angled out a bit for the drive, challenged near the sixteenth marker and held on gamely. MAGICAL MOMENT within striking distance, moved up three wide on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch, gained a short lead inside the final furlong, battled into the final furlong and faltered. KAYGOLD'S RUBY outrun five wide, moved in a bit, made a good four wide run on the second turn, angled out for the drive but lacked a late bid. LUCKY DRAGON broke thru the starting gate prior to the start, sprinted clear, set the pace inside, led the field to the final furlong and tired.

BLUE MON within reach along the inside, made a good run to the quarter mile marker but could not sustain the bid. REZIF outrun to the stretch, angled out for the drive and showed late interest. WAR ROMANCE outrun to the stretch, rallied belatedly. FLYING WARRIOR forwardly placed from the start, raced in the three path on the second turn and tired. SIX SHOTS (GB) was no threat. CORNWHISKEY close up four wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. RIP AND ROLL prominent three wide, faded.
