TELL IT, away in good order, went up to press pacesetting KAY'S MILLS while working her way inside, took over from that one in the upper stretch and was under intermittent lefthanded urging the remainder. MARIAHS LUCK, within striking distance, saved ground into the stretch, angled out four wide for the drive but couldn't menace TELL IT. A GIRL NEEDS CASH lunged in the air at the start while breaking slowly, was outrun for a half, made a run outside the winner in the upper stretch but failed to sustain the needed momentum. SOUTHERN SECRETS, wearing a nasal strip, was sluggish to begin, raced five wide much of the way, was outrun to the stretch and not a threat while improving position. QUITE RIGHT, well placed inside until the stretch, weakened in the drive. LE' CRYPTO, in a striking position four or five wide to the stretch, came up empty. KAY'S MILLS gained a clear lead inside early, made the pace for a half and weakened thereafter. INSTINCT wasn't a factor. POWERHOUSE BLUSH was outrun. CAPRICIOUSNESS was through early. MISS VOGUE gave way after a half.
