**Footnotes**

CONNECTED, reserved near the inside soon after the start, began to advance leaving the backstretch inside, moved between rivals four wide at the quarter-mile ground, rallied through traffic at the eighth pole four wide, then closed determinedly under strong handling to wear down BROKEN VOW. The latter, a bit difficult to load into the gate, moved up soon after the start to press the leaders, raced under rating when appearing full of run on the backstretch, took over approaching the stretch, drew well clear, then had no mishap while unable to last. OUTOFTHEBOX bobbed at the start and leaned in bumping CONCERNED MINISTER, was checked approaching the first turn and maneuvered in to race three wide while unhurried, edged closer nearing the final quarter, came out around CONCERNED MINISTER in the upper stretch, angled back to the rail in the final sixteenth and earned his position. FIRST LIEUTENANT, well placed near the inside from the outset, saved ground until the final quarter, came out four wide for the drive, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but came up empty. CHICAGO SIX, close up from the beginning while near the inside, moved three or four wide on the backstretch while between rivals, came out five wide for the drive but flattened out when the test came. CONCERNED MINISTER, bumped from both sides at the start and squeezed back in tight quarters, rushed to the fore soon after, made the pace for six furlongs and weakened gradually approaching the stretch. MAYSVILLE SLEW, outrun from the start, moved inside, then failed to reach contention while four wide in the stretch run. JADADA, well placed early, tracked the leaders five wide for nearly seven furlongs and tired approaching the stretch. JUST RULER came out at the start bumping CONCERNED MINISTER, raced in contention to the far turn and weakened thereafter.
