Footnotes

DA MULLETT tracked the dueling leaders early while four or five wide, took over in the final furlong, then lasted under pressure. ELECTRA BLUE, sluggish to begin and outrun for a half, came out seven wide leaving the turn, angled in to race between foes three or four wide in the late going and was getting to the winner at the end. POWER BAND drifted in while gaining the early advantage, held a slight edge inside, shook off HOPPLE at the furlong grounds, then couldn't last. REGAL MINISTER settled three wide early, split horses three or four wide entering the upper stretch but failed to sustain the needed momentum. BANDITO ROJO, never far back and five or six wide, lacked a late response. HOPPLE went up early to contest the pace outside of POWER BAND, battled up close into the stretch and weakened. PLAY FAST had no rally. TOWER QUEST, well placed to the stretch, flattened out in the drive. MATTY JUNIOR raced near the inside and wasn't a factor ATTHEENDOFTHE DAY, slow to start, never was close. CHEROKEE'S GLORY raced in contention for a half while five wide and tired. LAST CAVALIER gave way early.
