By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added, of which 62% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A set of four silver julep cups will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 19, 2005 with 30 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Eight and One Half Furlongs on the main track.

Footnotes

J'RAY, unhurried early, moved five wide on the far turn, came a bit wider into the stretch and was under steady encouragement to prevail. BEAU DARE, a bit rank early, drifted out on the first turn, continued ten wide on the backstretch, edged in slightly on the far turn, was clear into the lane and extremely wide, fell back leaving the furlong grounds, then dug in at the end to save the place. DYNA'S DESTINY chased front-running BEAU DARE from early on while three or four wide, took over four wide nearing the eighth pole, opened a clear advantage but weakened late. PERILOUS PURSUIT, outrun for a half, moved with the winner while outside that one on the far turn nearing the stretch and was empty late. READY TO TALK, reserved early and angled inside, moved five wide to make her run on the far turn but was empty when straightened into the stretch. LACY LINDSAY tired on the far turn. PARIS RETURN faded after a half. WARRIOR GIRL, six or seven wide, tired on the far turn and was pulled up immediately after the stretch call.
