TAKEN BY THE STORM forced the pace off the inside, gained a short lead on the second turn, drew clear when asked and was not menaced while under steady urging. CHANNEL ISLE forwardly placed four wide, moved in a path for the second turn but lodged only a mild bid for the place. MUGHAADIR angled in early when in hand, saved ground to the stretch, angled out with a furlong to go and lacked a late bid. RAKETE close up three wide, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. SUCCESSFUL BROTHERS out sprinted early, raced in the three path on the second turn and was no real threat. MARDOCHAI within striking distance inside, moved off the rail on the second turn and tired in the drive. HOLIDAY STAR outrun early three wide, saved ground on the second turn and failed to menace. AMEN KITTEN three wide early, was no factor. THUNDER within reach off the rail, faded. TAKIN THE SLOROAD four wide on the first turn, was outrun. BYTHELITEOFTHEMOON vied for the lead along the inside, held on well to the stretch and faded. BANG BANG BERTI trailed.
