FLEETING HONEY, forwardly placed inside, was angled out entering the stretch, gained command with a furlong to go and drew clear under steady handling. CINDY'S QUEST vied for the lead inside, was no match for the winner while best of the others. COME ON LOUISE broke slowly, quickly reached a striking position, was angled out once in the stretch but lacked a rally. PLEASANT PERFORMER, outrun early, raced five wide into the turn and improved her position in the drive. SWEET SIERRA alternated for the lead three wide and tired. PORT ISABEL forced the pace between horses and also tired. TAP THE ANSWER, within striking distance, raced three wide into the turn and gave way in the drive. LUCIE MON AMOUR was not a factor. CAFE RISQUE was outrun. RANBA tired three wide. MOUNT ROSE was outrun. LUSAKA CELEBRITY never menaced.
