Footnotes

SOLVIG settled in behind the leaders early, went along under patient handling, continued inside entering the stretch, lacked room at the furlong grounds, worked her way out to split foes five wide, then was fully extended to wear down KOPENHAGEN. The latter, well placed inside from the start, raced under light rating, rallied from the rail to take over leaving the furlong pole, was clear late between calls but was outfinished. HUMMINGBIRD RED went up early to force the pace three wide while outside of CRAWLEYVILLE, battled on about even terms into the final furlong and weakened late. FORTY GRAN bobbled at the start and leaned in bumping LAKE MEAD, was unhurried into the backstretch, raced in behind horses four or five wide, came out seven wide to secure room entering the stretch, loomed menacingly at the sixteenth pole but lacked a further account. SOIREE LADY, within striking distance, failed to rally. HOH DEAR (IRE), jolted at the start, followed the leaders five wide, remained prominent into the final furlong and flattened out. CRAWLEYVILLE drifted in at the start, moved inside to gain the lead, made the pace into the final furlong and faltered. GIBBS also drifted in at the start, went up to force the pace four wide, held on well until the stretch and tired. LAKE MEAD, bumped at the start, was outrun. EVROBI ducked in at the start bumping soundly with HOH DEAR (IRE), raced seven or eight wide on the backstretch and and was finished at the far turn.
