VIVID SUNSET, bumped at the start, was never far back while racing inside, took over on the turn, lost the advantage to ANOTHER from the outside in the upper stretch, then dug in through the late stages under strong handling to prove gamely best. ANOTHER ducked out at the start bumping the winner, gained the lead, lost it to VIVID SUNSET on the turn, regained the advantage in the upper stretch, then was outfinished. FRAN'S FLASH, well placed while following the leaders four wide, failed to rally. IDOL GIFT, in contention while following the leaders five wide into the final furlong, was empty thereafter. KELLY POND . GENDER MOTORS lunged at the start, bobbed and was bumped, then was outrun. SUGAR BEAR was never close. SMALL VICES was used early along the inside forcing the pace.
