TONTO TOO vied for the lead along the inside, drew clear in midstretch and held sway late. GONNA TELL MAMA close up from the start, challenged three wide on the turn, dropped back a bit in midstretch then was coming again late. JOE HOLLYWOOD forced the pace off the inside and tired late. GLORIOUS STRIKE close up along the inside, gave way. FRANKIE DAPPER drifted out at the start, was reserved along the inside and could not threaten. CALVADOS prominent four wide, faded in the stretch. MISTER DIXIE was outrun four wide. ST. IVAN forced back at the start, never menaced. TWO THREE TWO drifted in at the start, was straightened to race within striking distance while off the rail but tired. SILVER SPELL was outrun along the inside. UNSADDLED GLORY was no factor.
