RATATAT stalked the pace in hand, launched his bid three wide, forged command inside the three-sixteenths pole, opened clear and held safely. GIBSON opened clear to set the pace, was unable to match strides with the winner but stayed on well to prove second best. LOU BRISSIE was allowed to settle, circled four wide and was along in time to earn the show. ST. IVAN attended the pace along the inside, got through entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. IT DOESN'T ADD UP tracked the pace two wide, bid between horses on the turn, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. UNSADDLED GLORY failed to respond. OCASTA was unhurried into stride, came four wide but was never a factor. WINKATDAWAT saved ground to no avail.
