O'PRADO AGAIN tucked in to save ground, attended the pace along the inside, shifted out leaving the second turn, loomed large entering the stretch and gamely edged clear. HOGUE contended between horses, waited in traffic leaving the second turn, angled in entering the stretch, found room and finished well once clear. ROCK HARDER tugged between horses, worked his way to the outside on the backstretch, made an early move five wide, poked his head in front with three furlongs to run, lugged in through the drive and grudgingly gave way. MANX pulled to the lead toward the inside, fought gamely through a prolonged drive, but weakened late and faded. ST MOOSE tracked the pace between horses, moved with the winner through the second turn, drew even three wide, but flattened during the drive. DON'S BIRTHDAY was unhurried into stride, angled out five wide and finished with a belated gain. N. B. A. MONEY was bumped at the start, was unhurried into stride, came three wide and finished with a mild rally between rivals. MR SUPERNOVA saved ground to little avail. MAGELLAN was bumped at the start, settled near the tail of the field, swung five wide but lacked a response when called upon. FIRST MINISTER pressed the pace three wide through the second turn and dropped out. DUZY JASKO hopped at the start, was jostled between horses and never recovered.
