Footnotes

NEW BELIEVER, reserved early, angled out for the drive, raced in traffic in upper stretch, split rivals in midstretch then closed well to be up in time. STRIKE THE TIGER, within striking distance, inside, angled out five wide entering the stretch then finished willingly late. LIVE FROM APPOLLO, forced the pace four wide, drew clear in midstretch but could not last. EVACUATION ROUTE, outrun for a half three wide, closed well late. HOMEBOYKRIS, far back to stretch, rallied belatedly. PETERS ROCK forced the pace between rivals, dropped back on the turn, moved to the inside for the drive but lacked a late bid. SOUTHERN REGION, behind the leaders, raced five wide into the turn and lacked a late bid. ST. JOE was no threat. FISH, in tight early, recovered to race within striking distance but lacked a bid. TRULY AMAZING forced the pace three wide and tired. SUYETA, behind the leaders four wide, faded. NEW BAY vied for the lead along the inside and gave way.
