PERFECT STING, within striking distance three wide, moved closer after a half, challenged in midstretch and drew clear under steady handling. ON A SOAPBOX, within striking distance, moved closer inside before a half, was angled out for the drive, came wider in midstretch and finished willingly for the place. DANCE DIANE, outrun for a half, was angled out three wide with three furlongs to run when rallying, came four wide into the stretch and closed well late. PICO TENERIFFE, well placed from the start, move to challenge inside rivals in upper stretch but tired in the final furlong. SIMPLE WISH, closest to the pace off the inside, challenged the leader on the second turn, continued well to inside the final furlong and tired. POST PARADE, unhurried early inside, made a mild gain after a half but could not sustain the bid. TRICKLE CREEK MISS sprinted clear to set the pace, responded willingly when challenged on the second turn but tired in the final furlong. GOLD PIECE, unhurried off the inside, was not a factor. PYRITE VELVET, forwardly placed between rivals, was through after a half.
