REMAND settled in hand, came four wide to make his bid, shook clear with a furlong to run and widened through the drive. GALIENTOS was close up from between horses, was bottled up behind rivals leaving the turn, found room with a furlong to run and finished well once clear. LIVINGTHEGOODLIFE was forwardly placed along the inside, was hemmed in from the quarter pole to the sixteenth marker, slipped through and kept on willingly to earn the show. ROSSCAT was away slowly, angled in to save ground, swung five wide leaving the turn and was making up ground. CHIEF COMPLAINT broke slowly, angled out to be clear, made a middle move six wide, offered a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. GONE DIXIE GONE settled in hand toward the inside, angled out entering the stretch and improved his position late. LUYU broke sharply and set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed nearing the furlong marker and gave way readily. NINEWAYHIT chased the pace three wide, but faltered from between horses entering the stretch and faded. EL COMMODORE pressed the pace from between horses to the final furlong and dropped out. MAJOR AWARD was never a factor. DOOHAN showed little.
