Footnotes

KINGOFTHEBLUEGRASS attended the pace along the inside, got through entering the stretch, poked his head in front inside the furlong marker, and battled on tenaciously to just last. GRAND REALITY (ARG) was allowed to settle off of the inside, angled out four wide leaving the second turn, quickened late but was unable to reach the winner. WAY YONDER settled saving ground, split horses to commence his bid with a quarter to run, angled to the inside in the stretch, moved out and split horses again inside the furlong pole and was along for the show. STAGE SUCCESS made a middle move four wide, forged command entering the stretch but weakened during the drive and gave way. ZIEGFELD was allowed to settle, bid between horses leaving the second turn, came three wide but failed to sustain the drive. SACRED GROUND chased the pace three wide for six furlongs and faded. GRAND ROUGE opened clear to set the pace, was collared near the five-sixteenths pole and gave way readily once headed. METOO'SLEPRECHAUN was always outrun. ELECTRIC ALPHABET was fractious in the gate, broke in the air to get away behind his field, was unhurried into stride, angled out nearing the quarter pole to begin a rally but clipped heels and fell.
