MAY ONE was close up along the inside in hand, wheeled out four wide leaving the turn, took over at will and quickly drew clear as a handy winner. ADELINA ROSE was unhurried into stride, lacked room between horses and steadied near the three-eighths pole, worked her way forwardly between rivals through the second turn, angled out four wide and finished well to prove second best. TRIBECKY stalked the pace three wide, drew even entering the stretch, was no match for the winner in the drive, weakened further and settled for the minor award. ALBERTA'S BOOK jumped the sun break in the shadow of the rail near the wire first time past, settled into stride well back, made late rally circling five wide but failed to seriously threaten. POLO LOUNGE angled in to save ground, got through to make a mild rally but failed to menace. OH SUDANA contended between horses to the stretch and faded. KENTUCKY PEACHES set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed entering the stretch and gave way readily thereafter. HOLY AKADYA was hustled along three wide for a half and dropped out. HIGH CRY prompted the pace two wide, but came up empty between horses leaving the second turn and stopped.
