FORMULAFORSUCCESS was allowed to settle, ranged into striking distance three wide through the second turn, reeled in the leaders through the upper stretch, forged command a furlong out and was all out to just last. B'WANAGOLDMINE settled saving ground, moved with the winner leaving the second turn, waited in traffic near the three-sixteenths pole, altered course to the outside for room, finished well but was just kept at bay. MAX SILVERHAMMER was unhurried into stride, angled out to make a late rally and was getting to the top two too late. L J'S WAY settled in the second flight along the rail, shifted out entering the stretch and improved position. PLUTONIUM contested the pace three wide to the final furlong and faded. LONESOME STREET disputed the issue along the inside to the stretch and tired. FREE COUNTRY showed little. MONKEYINTHEMIDDLE attended the pace along the inside for six furlongs and dropped out.
