WISE DAN tracked the pace four wide under a snug hold, reeled in the leaders through the second turn, shook clear entering the stretch and held safely. IOYA BIGTIME hopped at the start, was unhurried into stride, came four wide entering the stretch, split horses nearing the furlong marker and finished willingly to earn the place. WORKIN FOR HOPS settled in hand, came four wide into the stretch, split horses and was along for the show. EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH settled saving ground, worked his way out between horses leaving the turn, came four wide and loomed a danger but lacked the needed late response. JIMMY SIMMS settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch, was blocked near the three-sixteenths pole, shifted out between horses but flattened during the drive. ANAK NAKAL was allowed to settle, came five wide and finished with a mild rally. DECISIVE MOMENT disputed the pace along the inside, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. GENERAL QUARTERS pulled to contention between horses, angled out entering the stretch but came up empty in the drive. MISSION IMPAZIBLE settled in hand, made a sweeping move five wide through the second turn but failed to sustain the drive. FUTURE PROSPECT vied for the lead three wide to the stretch and stopped.
