Weight: Three year olds, 122 lbs.; Older, 125 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes over a mile in 2004 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade II stakes over a mile in 2004 allowed 4 lbs.; a Grade III stakes at a mile or over in 2004 or \$60,000 twice at a mile or over in 2003-2004, 6 lbs. Stakes to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 20, 2004 with 20 nominations.

Footnotes

MIDWAY ROAD gained the lead inside early, edged clear for nearly a half while rated along under careful handling, was engaged by TOTAL IMPACT (CHI) from the outside nearing the five-sixteenths pole, was repeatedly bumped by that one from the three-sixteenths pole to the wire and proved gamely best under strong handling. TOTAL IMPACT (CHI) tracked front-running MIDWAY ROAD from early on while four wide, moved earnestly to challenge approaching the stretch, leaned in through the drive bumping the winner repeatedly thereafter and missed. ALUMNI HALL, unhurried early and four wide, inched to within striking distance on the far turn, moved five wide into the stretch, loomed a threat for the last eighth and came up empty. SONIC WEST settled near the inside early, swung out five or six wide entering the stretch and failed to menace. QUEST hopped at the start, raced in contention four wide until midway on the far turn and tired.
