Footnotes

LOST CAMPER sped to the fore despite veering out leaving the chute, was quickly straightened away and widened his advantage. SHAPE was unhurried into stride, came six wide to make his bid, finished well and was just up to earn the place. PETROMOM was close up in hand four wide, made his bid entering the stretch, but weakened slightly in the drive and settled for a minor award. COMEBACK contended between horses, ranged into striking distance through the turn, angled out entering the stretch but lacked the needed late kick. CHARLIE TRUMPER chased the pace two wide to the stretch and gave way. IRASCIBULL attended the pace four wide, but flattened out leaving the turn and faded. KENNER SWITCH settled near the back of the pack, came six wide to make a belated gain and improved his position through the lane. SHAKER LEMON PIE was reluctant to load and slow into stride, angled in to save ground but passed only the tiring ones. SOUTHERN SQUIRE was forwardly placed between horses, angled in entering the stretch but came up empty after five furlongs. EIGHTSUM was hustled along on the inside for a half and dropped out. KELODE showed little. SAWMILL saved ground to no avail.
