DUBIOUS MISS tracked the pace three deep in hand, assumed command leaving the second turn and drew away to score as the rider pleased. ANARKO (CHI) was away alertly to set the pressured pace, was unable to match strides with the winner but kept on well to hold the place. SLAM DUNK pressed the pace two wide, but faltered from between horses with three-sixteenths to run and dropped out. BOROBUDUR was through after a half.
