Footnotes

GRAND TRAVERSE lunged at the start, settled into stride between horses under a snug hold, gamely slipped through a narrow seam between foes with a sixteenth to run and was up in the final strides. WILD L stalked the pace in hand, launched his bid four wide, poked his head in front with a furlong to run, kept on well but was denied late. KNIGHTS CROSS dueled for the lead off of the inside, battled through a prolonged drive but wasn't quite good enough. ACCREDIT attended the pace along the inside, was hemmed in leaving the turn and through the stretch, and went evenly while not urged late. TEND broke a step slow, settled into stride at the tail of the field, advanced four wide through the turn, drifted in a bit entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. LUCK MONEY (IRE) was allowed to settle, came five wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. GOLDZAR contested the pace to the outside of KNIGHTS CROSS, but faltered from between horses with a furlong to run and dropped out.
