Footnotes

FABER dueled outside rival into and around the turn, roused in upper stretch, gained advantage then edged away nearing the wire. SPENDER CHIC contested the pace from inside the winner, under asking to remain alongside that rival into the lane, could not go with winner in final sixteenth but held second. I OWE UME tracked the leaders from along the rail then two wide, came out some in upper stretch and closed gap on runner-up late. WARREN'S GINA was off bit slow, stalked from between rival early then two wide, continued along the rail in the lane and gained minor award. ROCKSTER angled in early to gain striking position, stalked on three wide path around the turn and went evenly to the wire. BIG CHECK FRIDAY settled while slightly off the rail, chased three then two wide to the stretch, came out some late but never menaced. AVRIL IN PARIS bumped at the start, chased three deep early then three wide into the bend, dropped back some and lacked any rally. AWESOME VARIETY reserved while well off the rail, chased four wide to the turn, came out further around the bend and was no factor. SUNDAY WHISPER broke in and bumped rival, lagged back from off the rail, continued four wide and was outrun.
