TECHNICIAN was reluctant to load, still broke alertly and quickly sped well clear, padded that cushion around the turn and proved best under steady handling. WARREN'S SANJAYA settled off the pace, shifted over early, gained the inside, remained along the rail and edged away for the place. OLD MAN WHO angled over early, chased from outside foe, remained two then three wide into the stretch and gained the show. GREENWICH PARK (SAF) was off bit slow, trailed early, raced from slightly off the rail then along the fence in the lane and improved placing. THE ROBSTER reserved off the pace, chased two wide then three wide around the turn, remained on same path and was no threat. EVERYNOW AND THEN stalked early from along the rail, dropped back a bit, came two wide into the lane and weakened. SCOTT'S SPIRIT unhurried from between horses, chased from off the rail, came three wide leaving the turn and lacked any response. CUSTOM CONTINENTAL chased early from the outside then between horses, later shifted to the inside but was never a factor. MO'S LIL' INDIAN broke in and steadied to be off slow, chased four wide to the turn and never menaced. WHYA DA WHYA stalked while outside foe, was closest pursuer into the turn, dropped back then was four wide leaving the turn and faded.
