BELATED BID flashed keen early foot while crossing over, retained clear cushion from the inside into the stretch and proved best under one tap of the stick and mild hand pressure. HYPER LASS unable to go with winner early, was closest pursuer into and around the turn, drifted out under left hand urging in the drive and finished willingly. WARREN'S CARLIE settled off the rail, chased three wide, came in some leaving the turn and was along late for third. MARY THE PRINCESS reserved from the inside, saved ground into the stretch and lost the show late. SOLO CONTESA hopped leaving the gate, settled outside, continued four then three wide and lacked needed response. CATLEDO between horses early, lagged back from off the rail, continued three then four wide into the lane while no threat. ECLIPSE SYRAH chased from the inside, dropped back around the turn and weakened.
