**Footnotes**

TURNAGAIN TAYLOR bumped at the start, set pressured pace from off the rail, remained on three wide path into the lane, edged away and just lasted. HE'S THE DEVIL settled off the pace and bit off the fence, shifted in, secured the inside, skimmed the rail inside AFLEET RIVER into the lane, steadily closed and narrowly missed inside winner. KINDACATCHY was off a bit slow, unhurried from the inside, also gained the rail, rallied strongly in late stages and was along for the show. STEAMY STORY stalked leaders from the inside, chased two wide around the turn, drifted out further into the lane and improved placing. FOR CONTRAST prominent early from the outside, chased three then four wide into the lane and weakened from the far outside. AFLEET RIVER forced the early issue from the inside, raced two wide into the stretch and faded. TOP LEESE bumped with outside foe at the start, prompted the early pace, continued on three wide path into the stretch and weakened.
