FALL APART gained stalking position from outside foe, continued three then four wide into the stretch, reached the front passing sixteenth marker and edged away under urging. AGILITY chased on two wide path and outside foe to the turn, angled out leaving the bend, closed some from the outside and was along for the place. OUR SENIOR MOMENTS chased from along the fence early then two wide on the turn, regained the rail in the drive and nailed rival for third. ROYAL GRAY bumped leaving the gate, tracked pace from inside eventual winner, came three wide into the stretch, loomed between rivals but failed to sustain effort late. LOCKSMITH trailed early, gradually shifted over, exited the turn two wide and finished with interest from between horses. WYLIE N WYATT reserved early while angling over some, chased three wide on the turn, drifted out leaving the bend and failed to menace from the outside. CABO SAN LUCAS bumped leaving the gate but still sped clear, set uncontested pace to the stretch, was overtaken passing sixteenth marker and gave way.
